We are in office since morning. We stocked necessary quantities of diesel, vegetables and provisions. The services at canteen and coffee pantry are normal. Only a few faculty and only two office staff attended office today. Students/PDFs strength is normal at coffee pantry & canteens. Water at Institute premises and guest house complex is maintaining the same level close to knee deep level every where. We couldnot pump out water as levels are equal. Even on the main road [our gate to WPT] water level is same.

Two research scholars who stay on their own with family/mother approached us and we provided two rooms in guest house as water entered into their houses outside.

All the research scholars including a family of SRF staying at Thoraipakkam flats are brought to the Institute and provided rooms in guest house as the water level at Thoraipakkam flats is increasing minute to minute with present status as more than waist level. As per reports there is a possibility of increase in the water level there hence in consultation with the research scholars we brought them here. Though the shuttle operator denied to operate we forced and completed this task. Otherwise situation is under control.
